- **Assist** with rehearsal room setup 30 minutes before rehearsal begins.
- **Connect with singers and care partners**: Interact with all in a friendly, compassionate, and non-judgmental way, creating a space where everyone feels valued and supported.
- **Courtesy calls to absent singers**: Reach out to singers who are unexpectedly absent to check in, offer support, and remind them they're missed. These calls help maintain our close-knit community and ensure that no one feels left behind.
- **Assist** at end of semester concerts
- **Optional administrative support:** Occasionally assist with office tasks as outlined in our weekly newsletters, if you're interested in additional involvement.
